Personality

When God saved you he didn't alter your personality – he sanctified it!

God created you, knows you, and will use you as you are. He will refine you and smooth off the rough edges as you grow in His Spirit. We must never attempt to be someone we are not, but rather allow God to use our own personality to reach others.

You are not just a body. In fact your body is a container that hold the real you. You are something deeper, something greater, something more spiritual. Your body holds your soul and your spirit, the true essence of who you are.

God will use your personality

When God saved you He did not overhaul your personality. He only sanctified (set apart for a special purpose) your personality. God will continue to use your personality as you follow Him in ministry, in your field of business, in your daily life. There are various blessings and risks with each personality type:

1. Humorous Personality

This person is excellent at using humor to break the ice or mix it with their message

Positive results: everyone likes a funny story

Negative results: too much humor in the wrong place can destroy conviction

2. Serious Personality

This person comes across as very serious in their words and thoughts

Positive results: people know that they mean what they say

Negative results: at times the person can appear as negative and cold

3. People Person Personality

This person loves to be around people and enjoys their company

Positive results: they will have a lot of personal friends in life

Negative results: they will get burned by some people that they get close to

4. Touchy Feely Personality

This person likes close contact, and uses their hands to reach out to people

Positive results: people are not intimidated with their warmth and sincerity

Negative results: people may think that their actions are too friendly (contact must be tempered – know who you can and cannot have contact with)

5. The Quiet Personality

This person does their work quietly and seldom engages in conversation
Positive results: they get along in almost any situation without complaining
Negative results: they are hard to read and often make friends at a slow pace

6. **The Loud Personality**

This person always talks loud and can be heard above everyone else
Positive results: they usually get things accomplished
Negative results: they will eventually get on people's last nerve

7. **The Spiritual Personality**

This person is always talking about God, the Bible, church, and prayer
Positive results: usually leaders, intercessors and great prayer warriors
Negative results: Can come across as so spiritual they cannot be a friend to unsaved people
